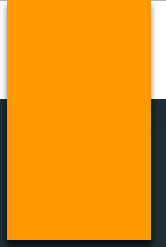


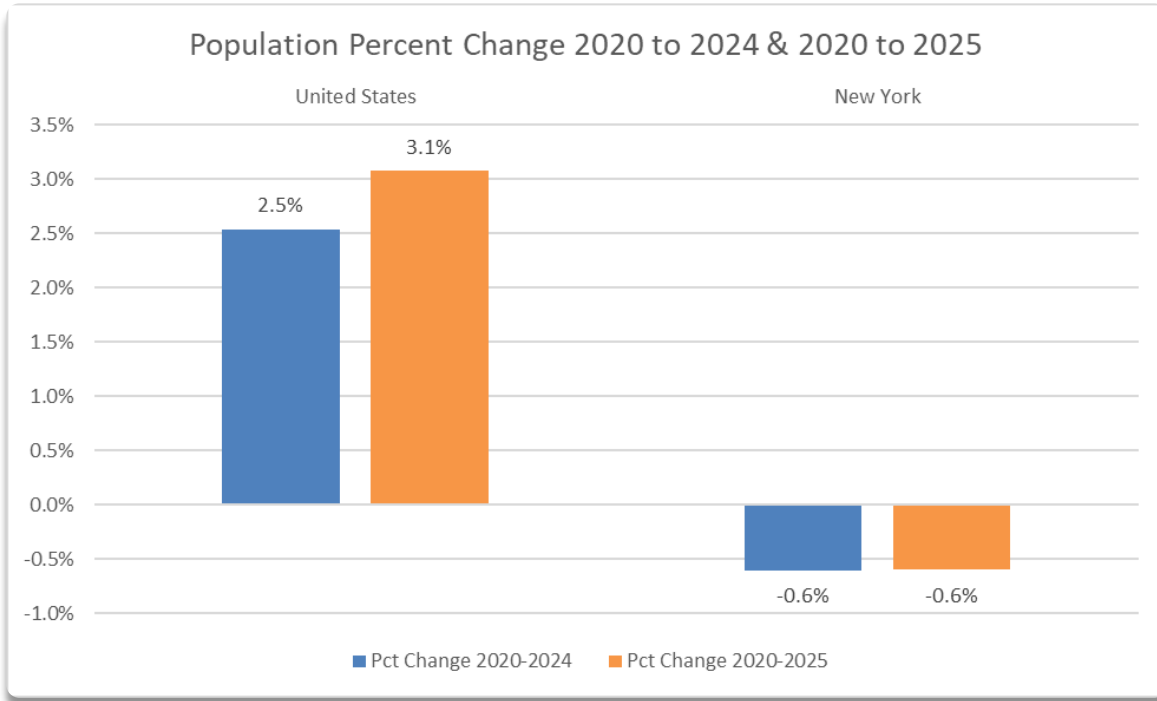

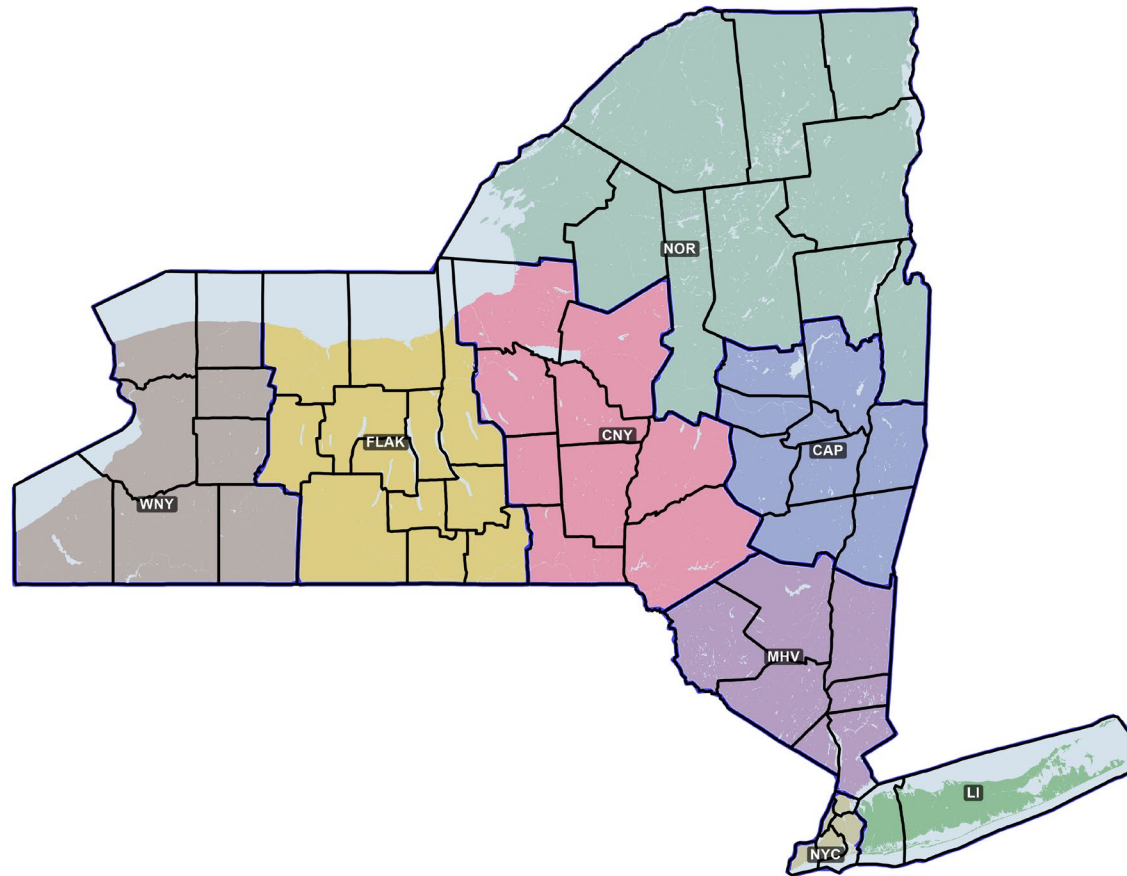


# Population Change in US and NY

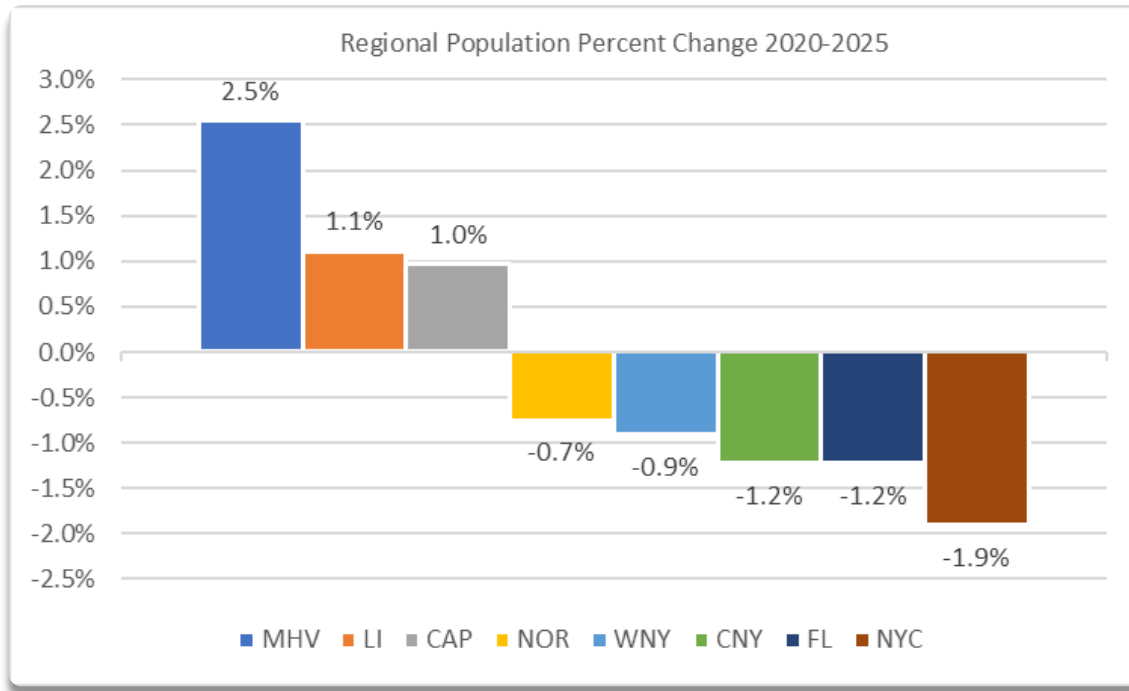


- ▶ The US has seen much population growth.

# 2020 through 2025 ACS Population Estimates



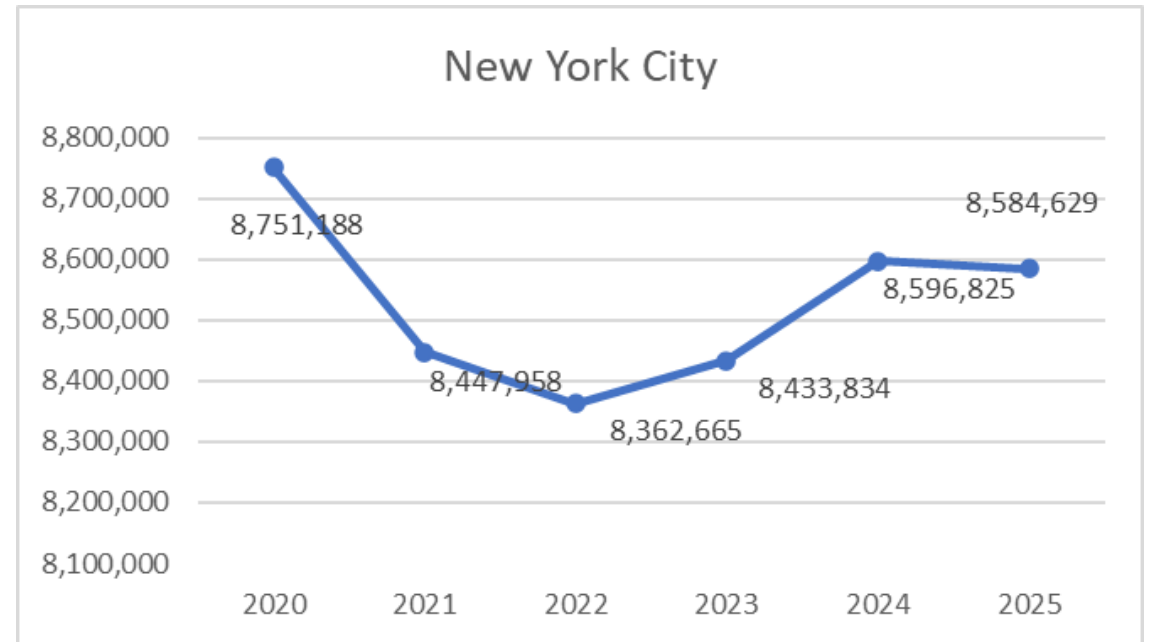
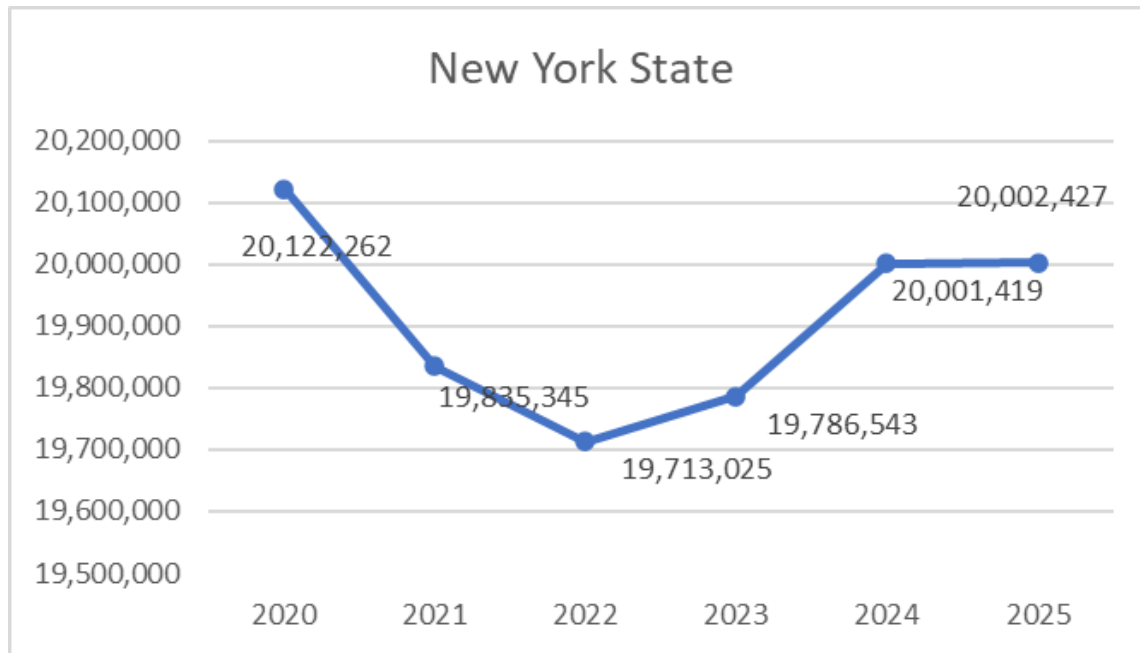
MID HUDSON VALLEY, CAPITAL REGION AND LONG ISLAND EXPERIENCE POPULATION GROWTH SINCE 2020.

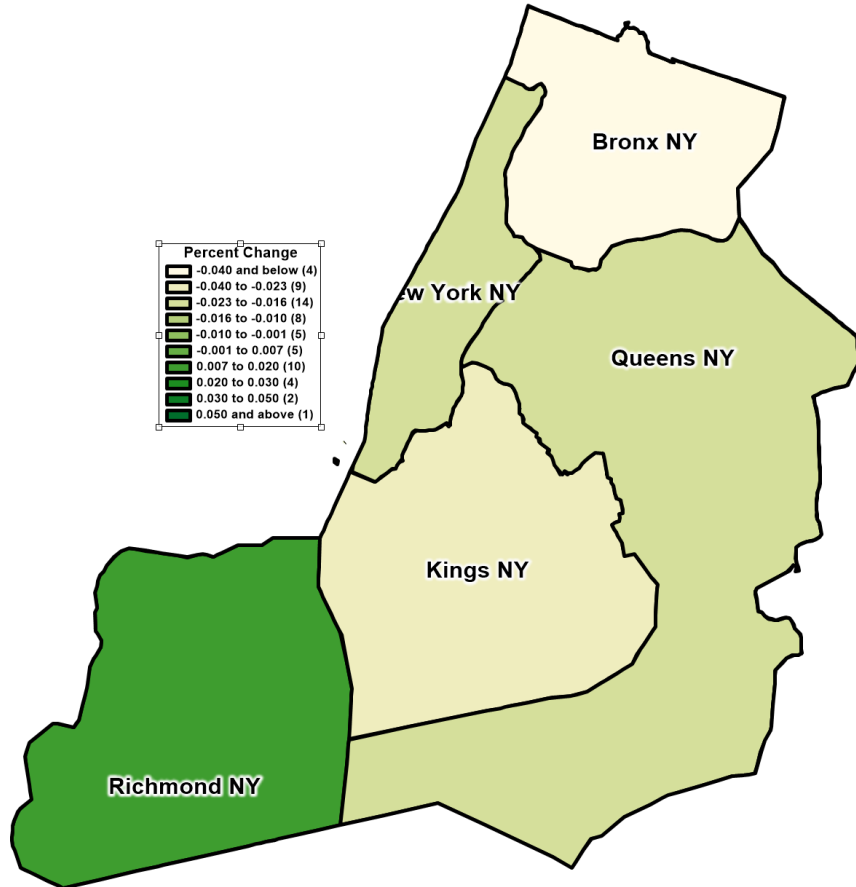
► In the last year Western NY, Finger Lakes and Central NY, and North Country experienced slight declines.

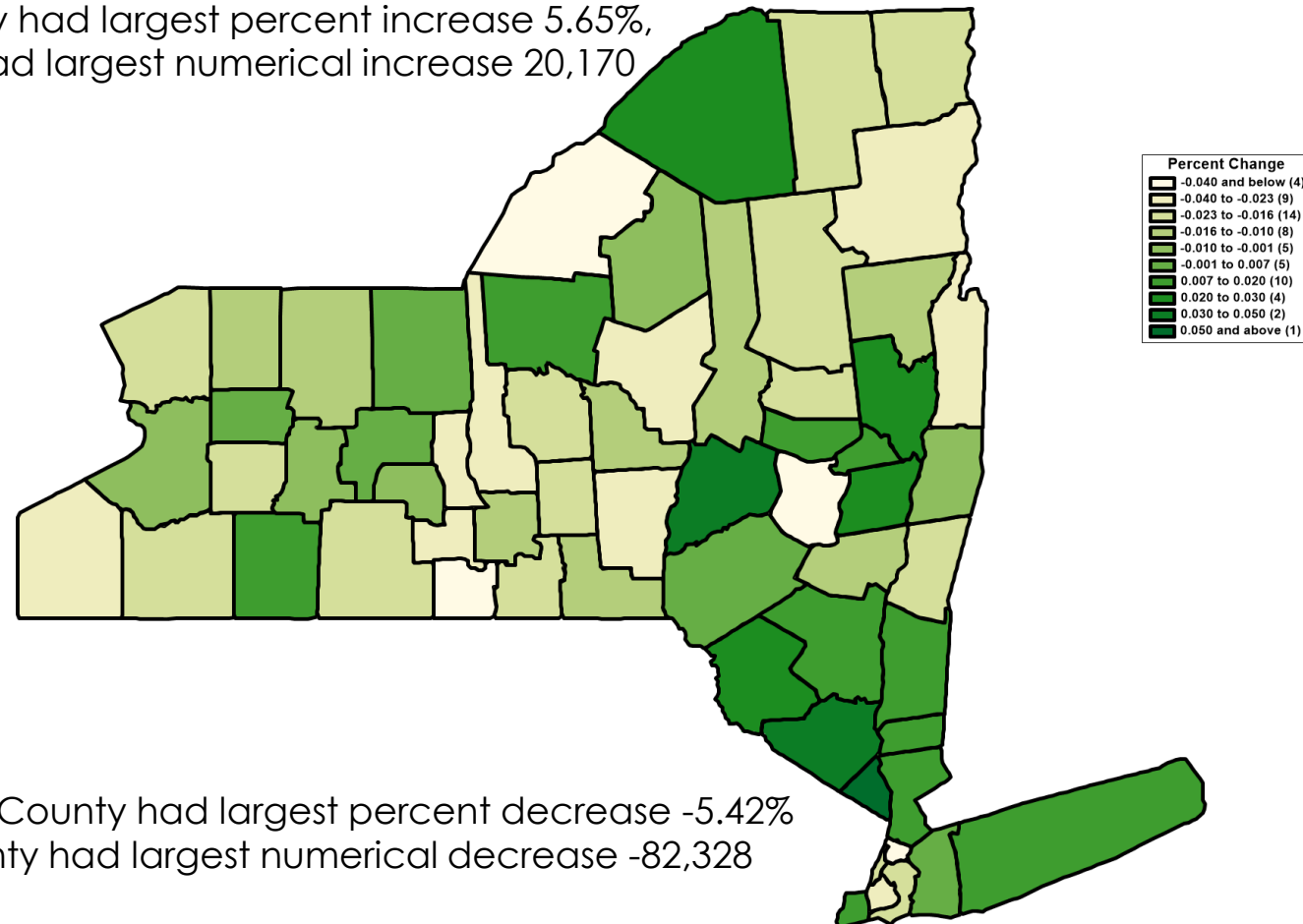

# Population by County: Percent Change 2020-2025

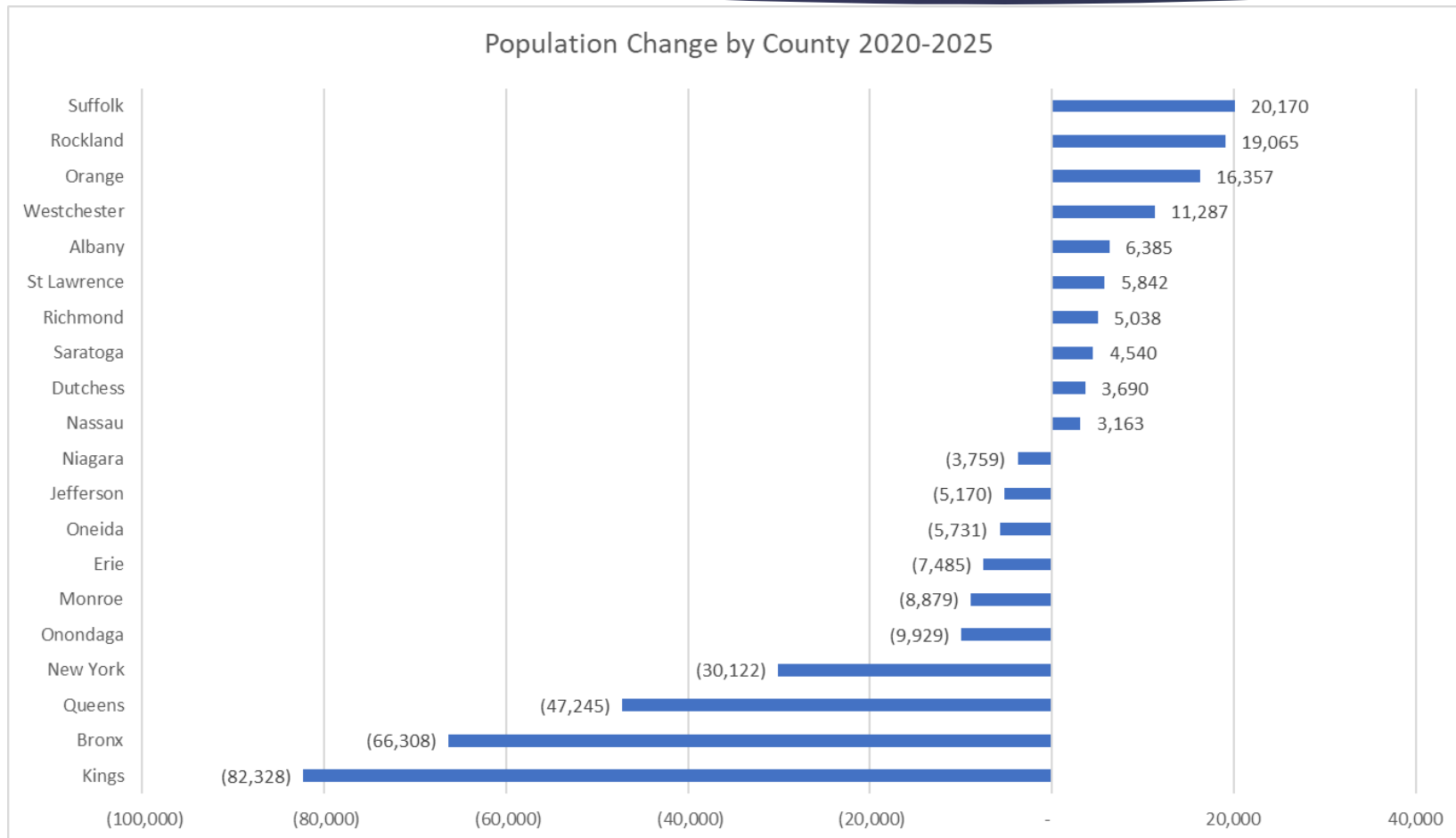


Rockland County had largest percent increase 5.65%,  
Suffolk County had largest numerical increase 20,170



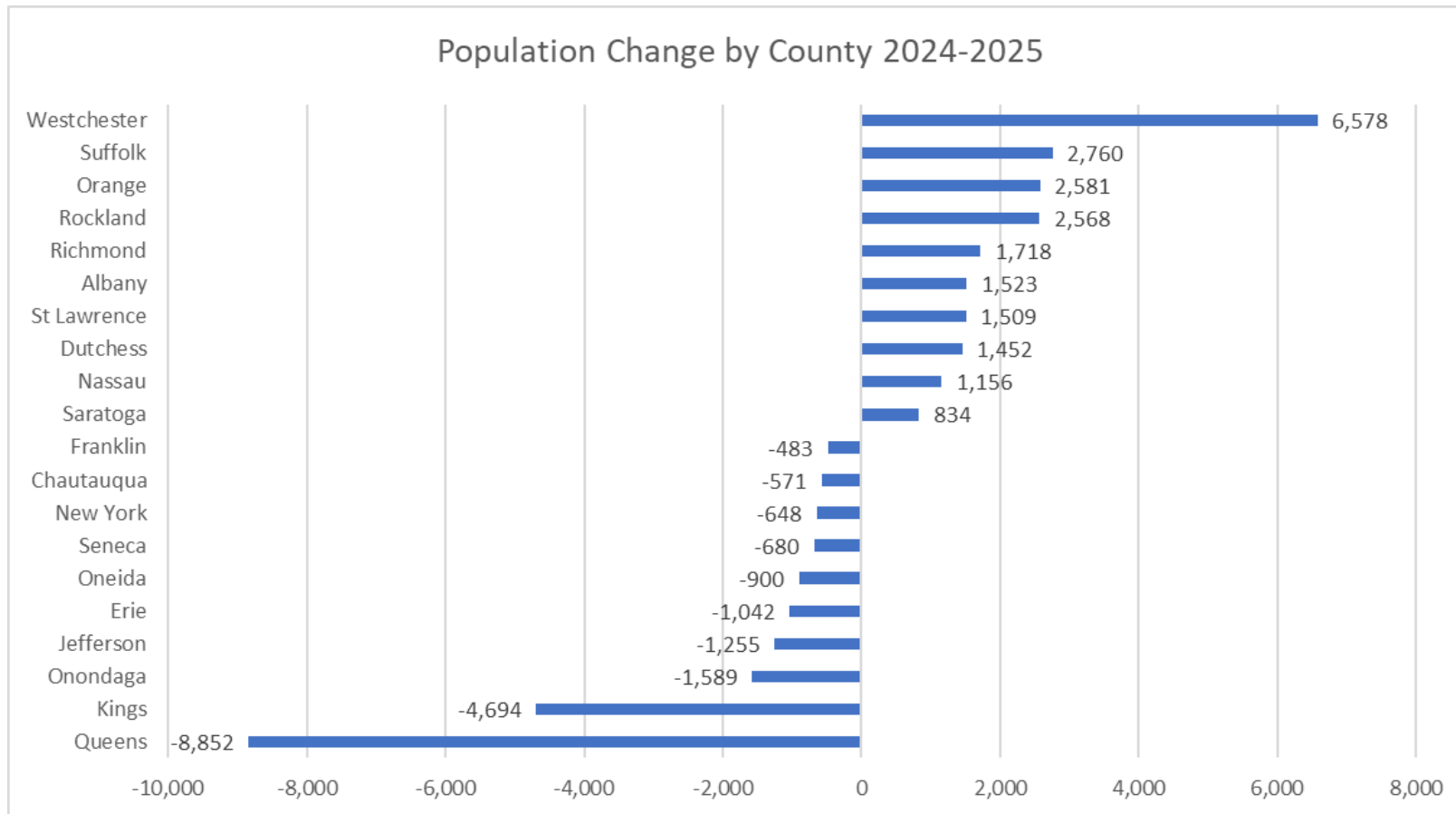
Schoharie County had largest percent decrease -5.42%

# Counties with Largest Numerical Increases & Decreases 2020-2025



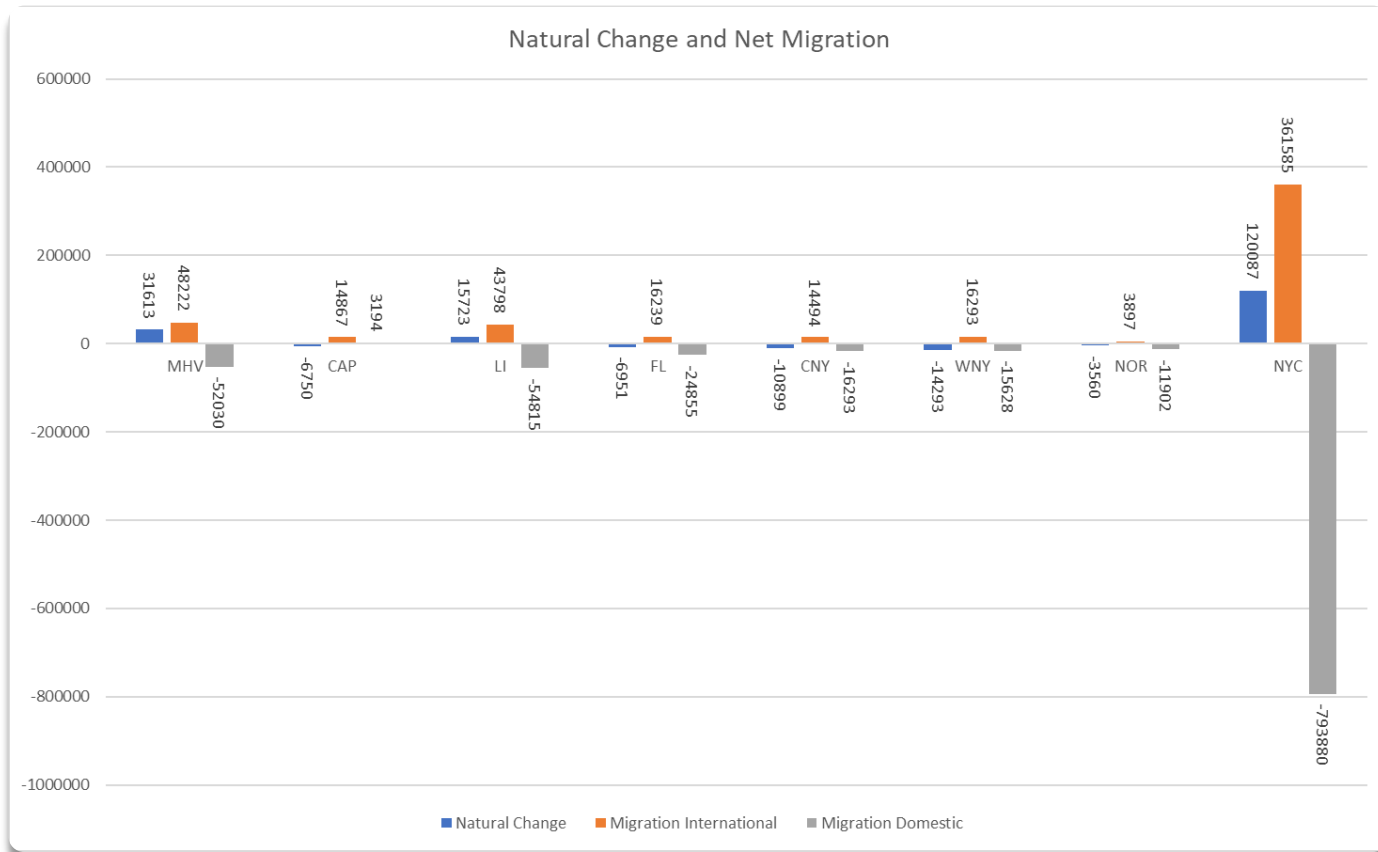
- Orange, Suffolk and Rockland experienced most growth since 2020.

- Kings and Queens had slight losses.

# Components of Change 2020-2025



- ▶ MHV and LI and NYC experienced net positive natural change (Births – Deaths), yet also experienced outmigration to other states.
- ▶ All regions except for CAP experienced domestic outmigration.
- ▶ NYC has highest number of births and international immigrants, but also 82% of the outmigration to other states.
