Hello, my name is Ronald Wheelock and I am submitting testimony on behalf of the Sauquoit Valley Central School District.

This school district represents approximately 950 students and covers the towns of Paris, New Hartford, Litchfield, Bridgewater, Marshall, and Frankfort. Our district is also represented in both Oneida and Herkimer counties. I write today to participate in New York's newly implemented independent redistricting process and the effects redistricting will have on our community.

As a community of interest we are focused on providing a solid public education to the students of our region. Maintaining the Sauquoit Valley Central School District within a single legislative district would ensure our elected leaders understand our issues and are focused on advocating for them at the state and federal level.
