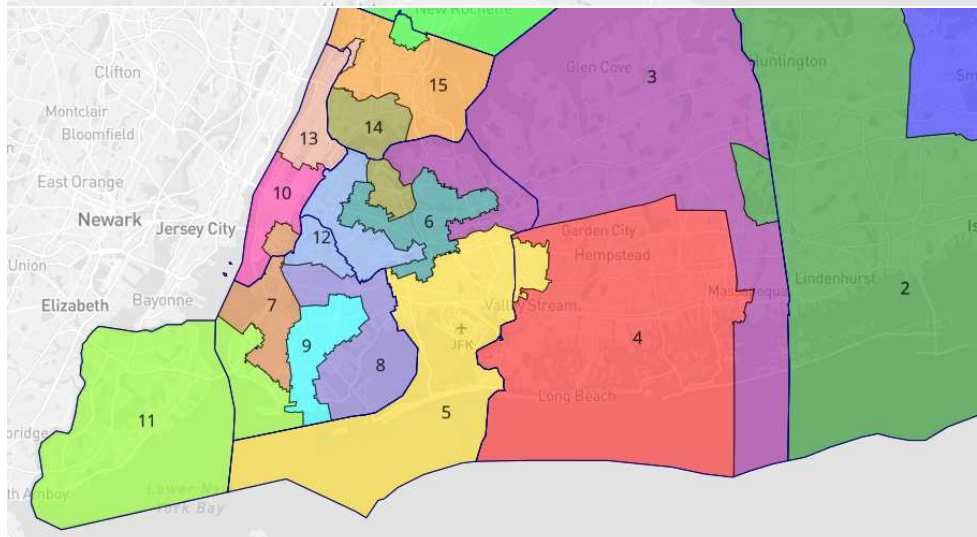
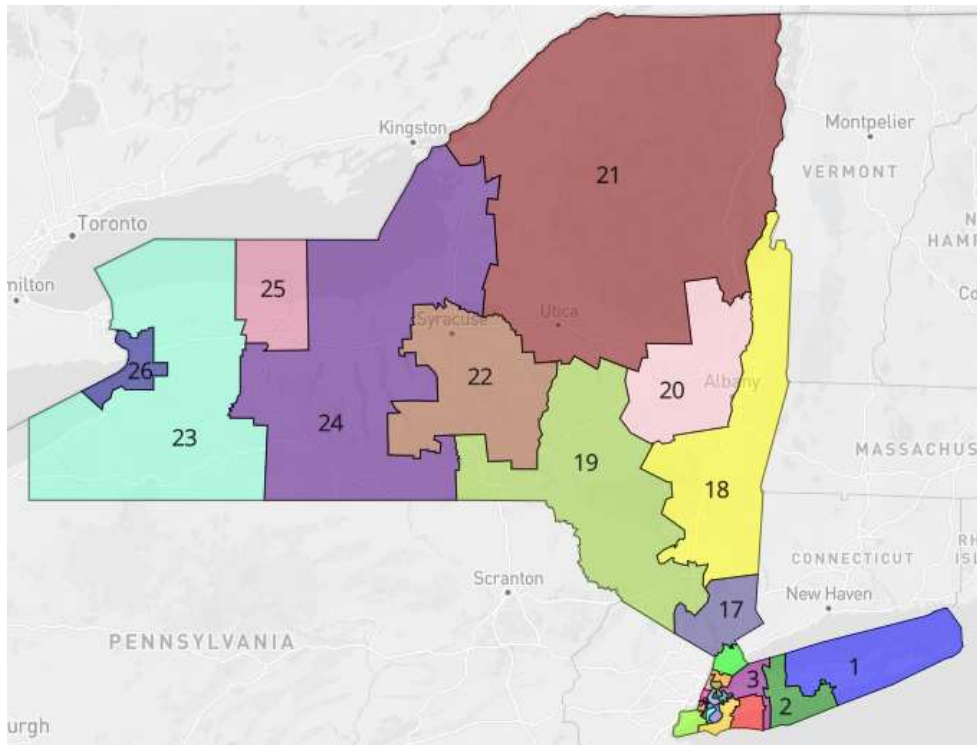


## Lars Dahl Redistricting Handout

All nine maps were drawn using Dave's Redistricting App using census data adjusted to avoid prison gerrymandering. My proposed changes to the maps that were drawn by the commission reflect an effort to keep the basic structure of the districts provided in the drafts intact, while also improving communities of interests, reducing the number of precinct, town and county splits, and lowering population deviations of districts. All racial makeup information was based off the citizen voting age population not the total population of each district. 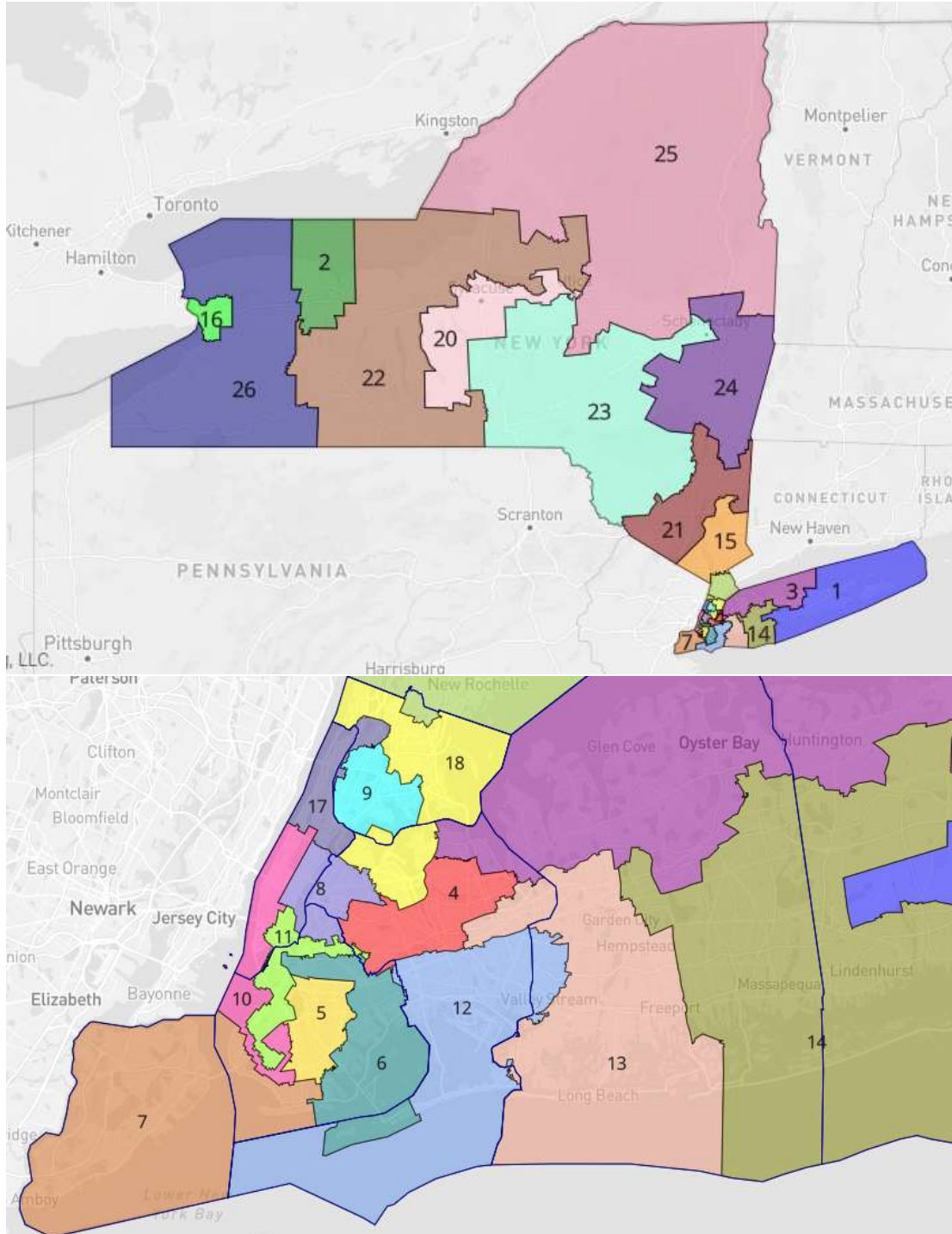
Map 1: My proposed congressional districts:

- No precincts are split
- No districts are split into more than 2 counties.
- No county is in more than 2 districts north of New York City
- 1 population deviation above 2,000 people (District 21)
- 1 town split north of New York City (Greenburgh)
- 3 Majority Black Districts- 1 more than the current map (Districts 5, 8 and 9)
- 2 Majority Hispanic Districts- the same number as the current map (Districts 14 and 15)
- 1 Majority Asian District- 1 more than the current map (District 6)
- 10 Total Majority Minority districts- 1 more than the current map



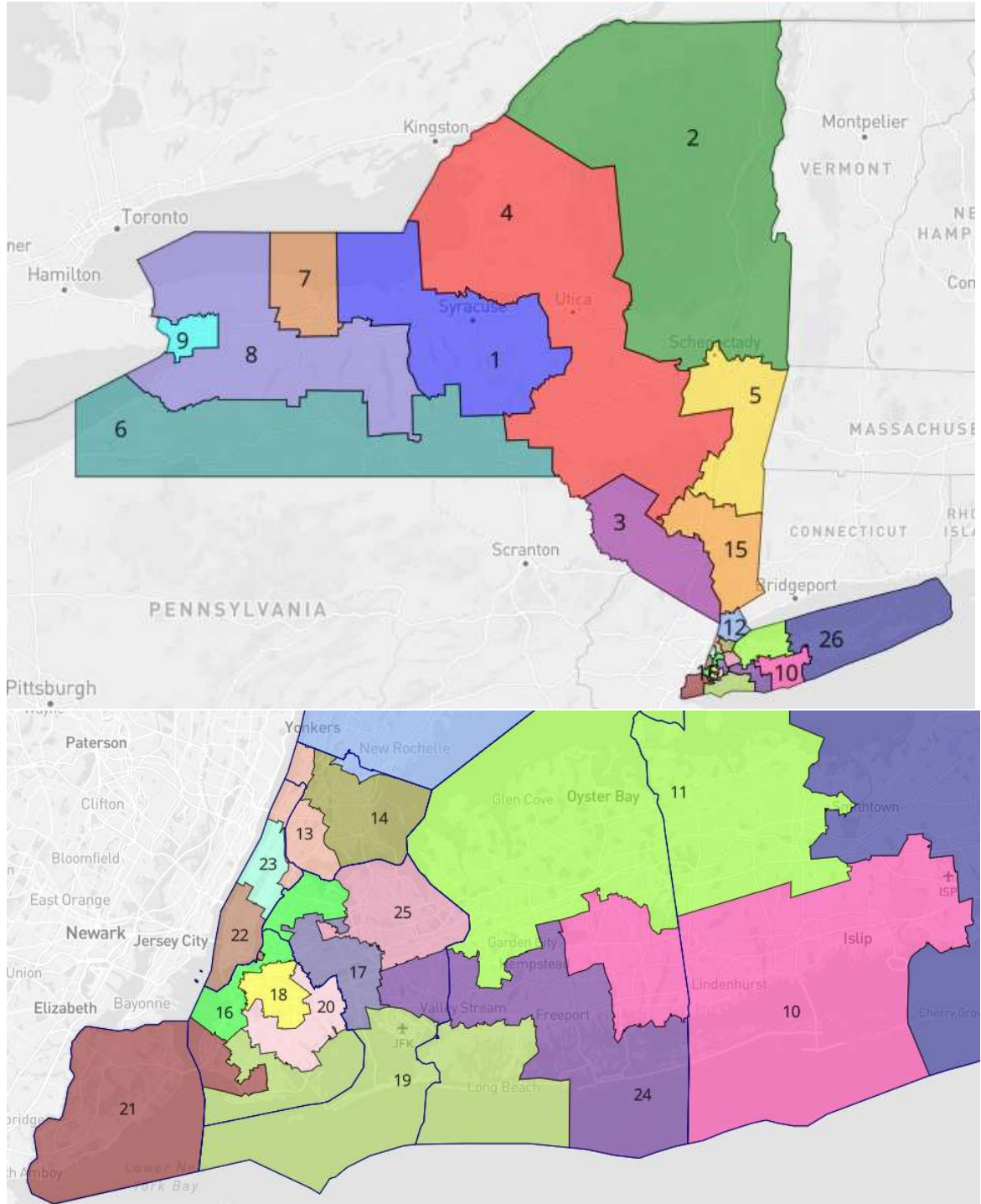
Map 2: My proposed changes to the “Letters” congressional districts

- Better communities of interest
- 557 precinct splits- 144 fewer precincts split than the proposed map
- 13 county splits north of Westchester- 3 fewer counties split than the proposed map
- Greatest population deviation is 1.
- 16 town splits north of Westchester- 11 fewer town splits than the proposed map



Map 3: My proposed changes to the “Names” congressional districts

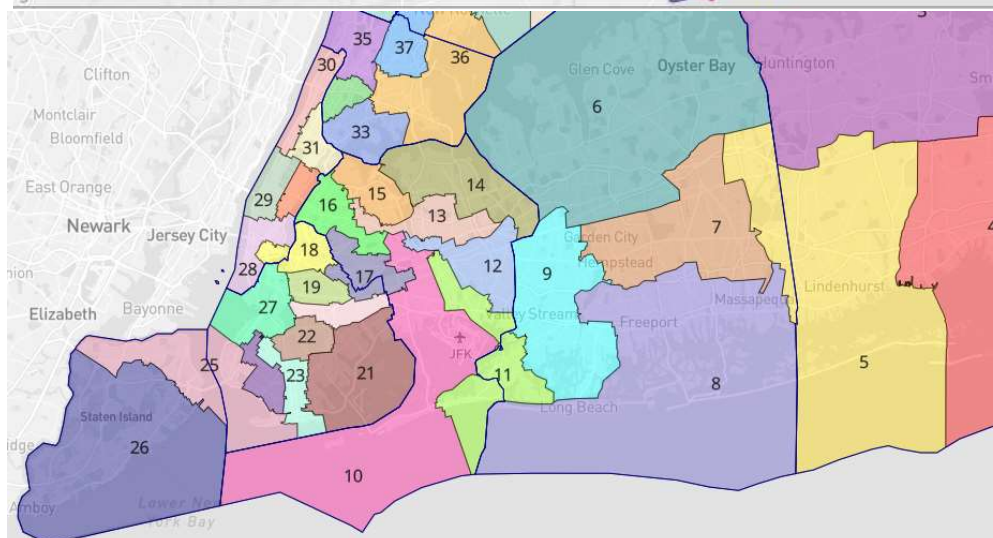
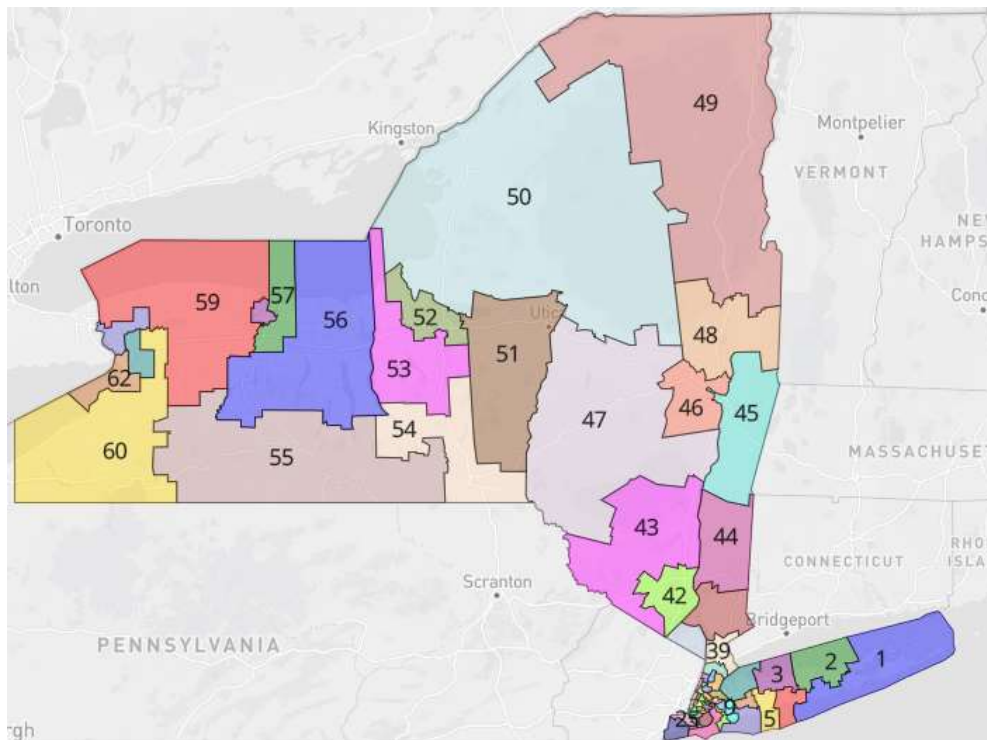
- Better communities of interest
- 0 precincts split- 123 fewer precincts split than the original proposal
- 10 county splits north of Westchester- 3 fewer counties split than the proposed map
- Greatest population deviation is 1.
- 15 town splits north of Westchester- 12 fewer town splits than the proposed map





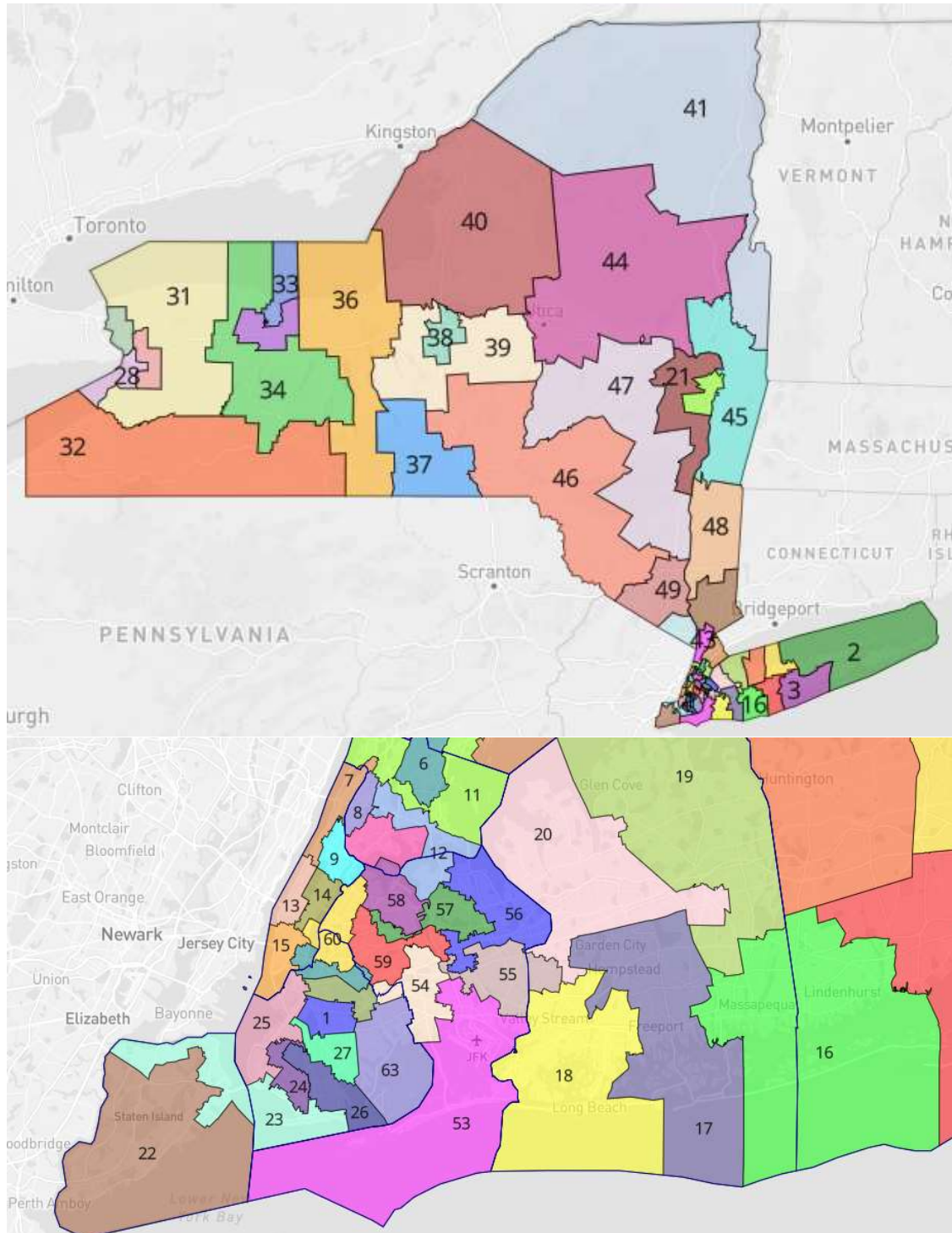
Map 4: My proposed state senate districts

- No precincts split
- No districts split more than 2 counties.
- 2 counties north of Westchester are in more than 2 districts (Erie and Monroe)
- 2 towns split north of NYC (Buffalo and New Rochelle)
- 4 town splits in Long Island (all but one for population deviation and VRA compliance)
- 7 Majority Black Districts- 1 more than the current map (11,12,19,20,21,22 and 37)
- 6 Majority Hispanic Districts- 3 more than the current map (15,17,30,33,34 and 35)
- 3 Majority Asian Districts- 2 more than the current map (13,14 and 24)
- 23 Total Majority Minority districts- 2 more than the current map



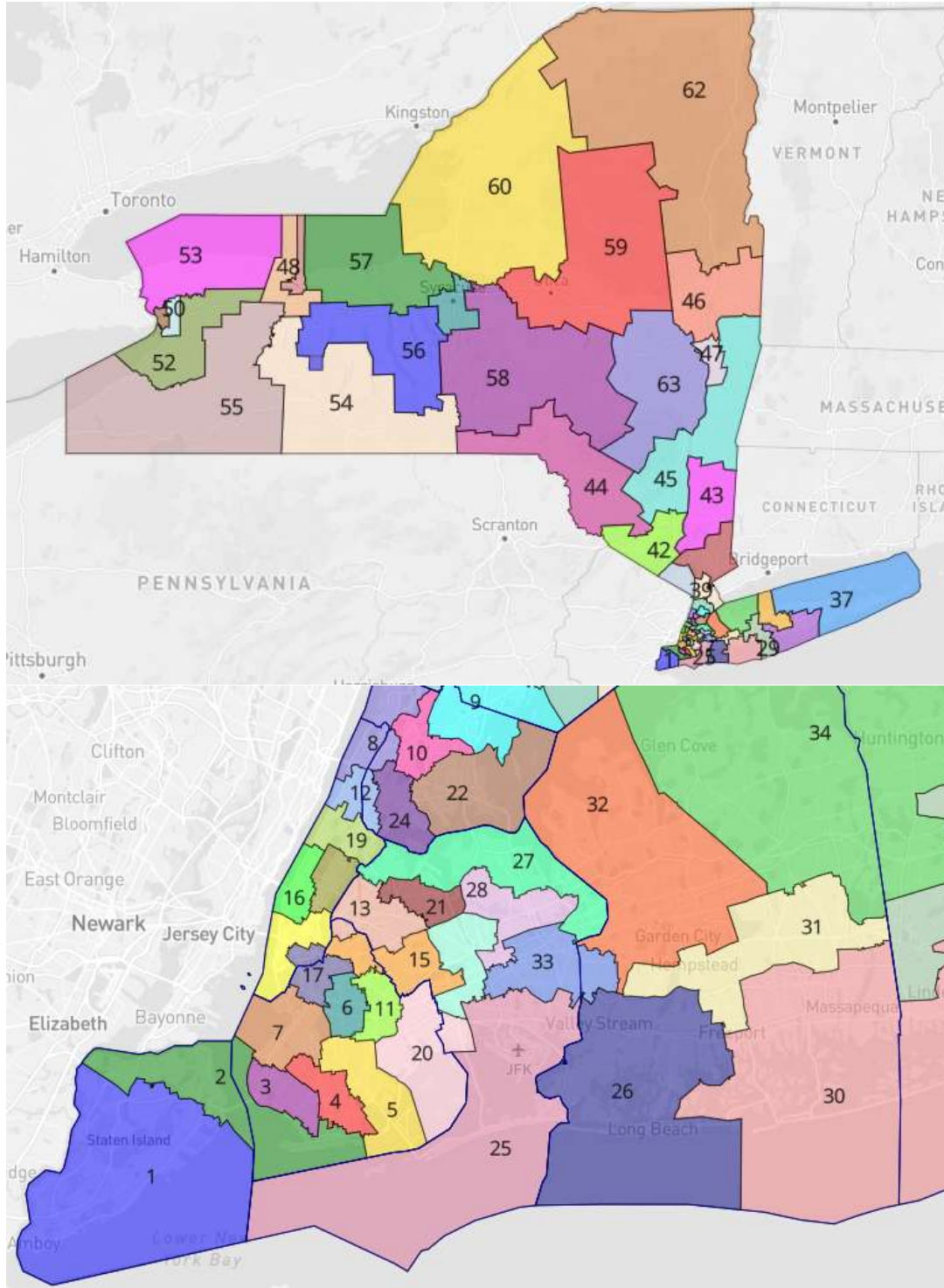
Map 5: My improvements to “Letters” state senate districts

- Better communities of interest
- 1 precinct split- 301 fewer split than the original proposal
- 18 counties split north of Westchester - 5 fewer than the proposed map
- 1 population deviation over 3,000– 24 fewer than the proposed map
- 3 town splits north of New York City- 30 fewer than the proposed map



Map 6: My improvements to “Words” state senate districts

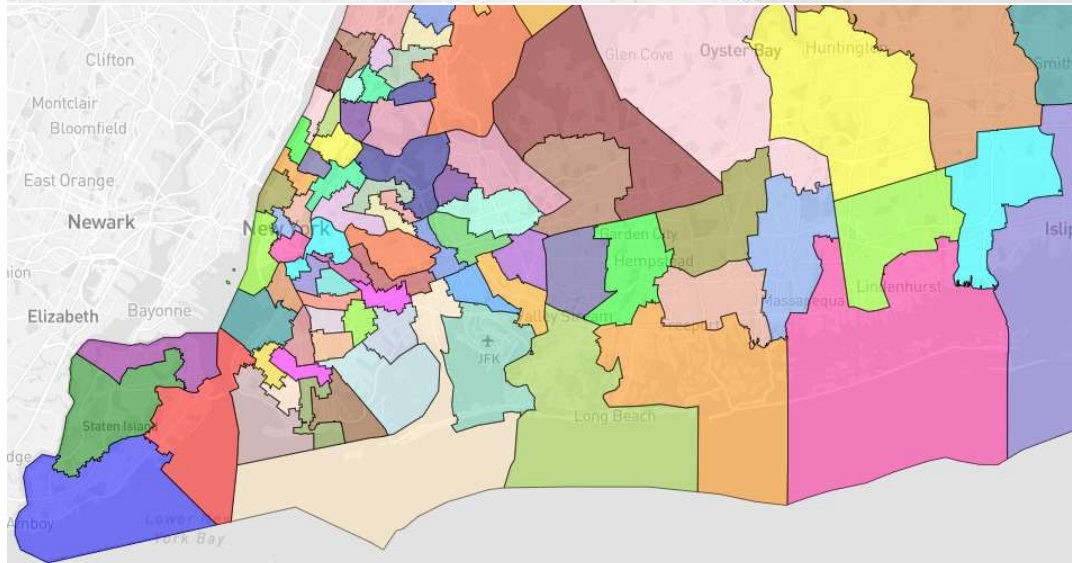
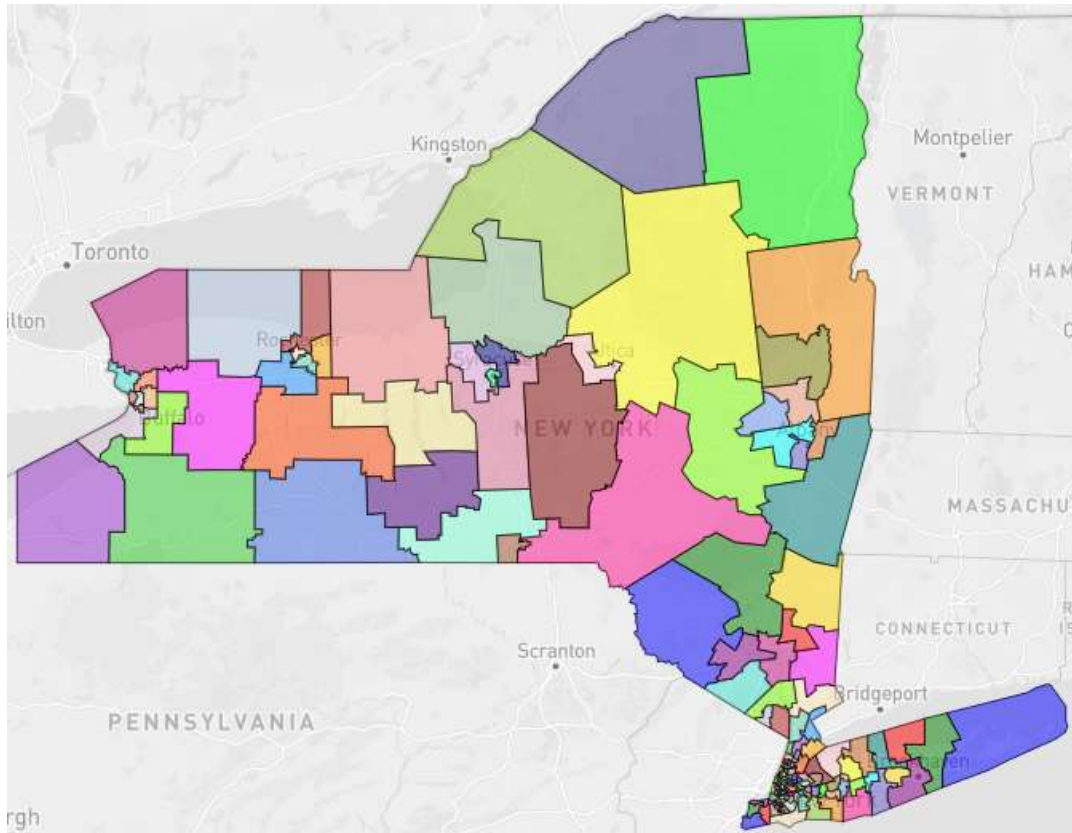
- Better communities of interest
- 1 precinct split- 301 fewer split than the original proposal
- 20 counties split north of Westchester- 6 fewer than the proposed map
- 2 population deviations over 3,000– 3 fewer than the proposed map





Map 7: My proposed assembly districts

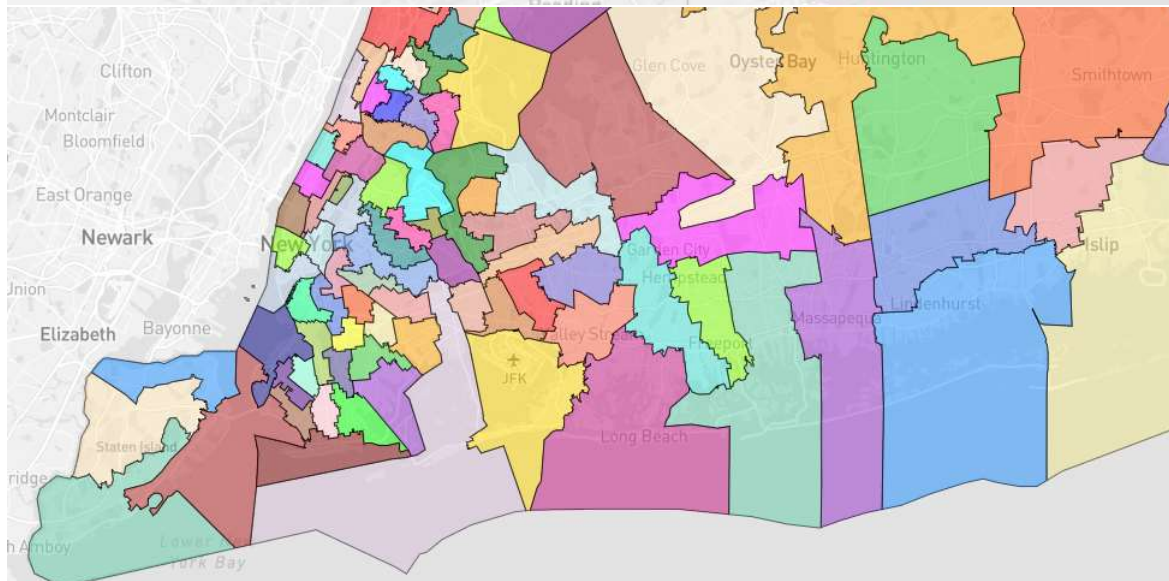
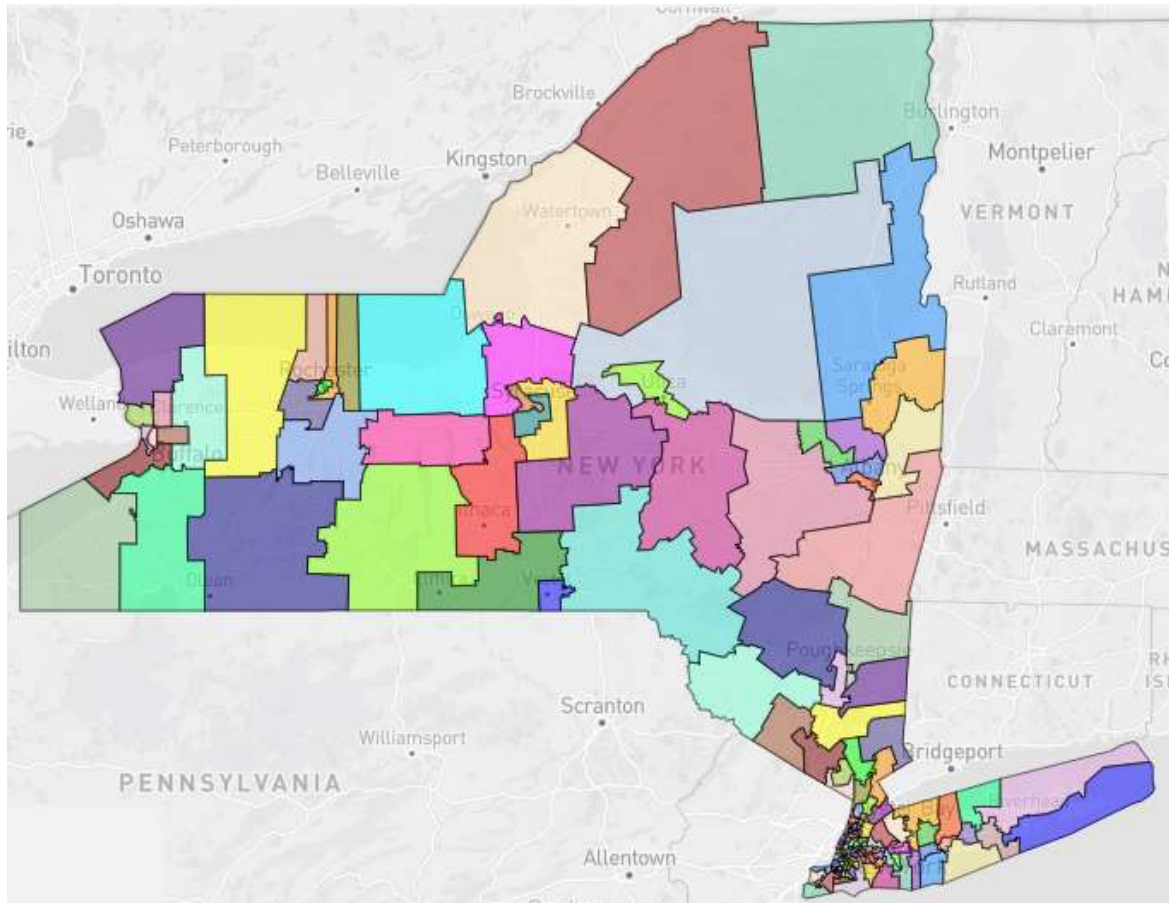
- No precincts split
- 6 towns split north of Westchester– 3 fewer than the current map
- 16 Majority Black Districts- 1 more than the current map
- 15 Majority Hispanic Districts- 3 more than the current map
- 4 Majority Asian Districts- 1 more than the current map
- 61 Total Majority Minority districts- 5 more than the current map





Map 8: My improvements to “Letters” assembly districts

- Better communities of interest
- No precincts split – 625 fewer than the proposed map
- 9 town splits- 37 fewer than the proposed map
- Greatest population deviation is 3,495- 3762 fewer than the proposed map



Map 9: My improvements to “Words” assembly districts

- Better communities of interest
- No precincts split – 1,748 fewer than the proposed map
- 9 town splits north of Westchester- 6 fewer than the proposed map
